

CHARTER

1. Official Designation: Board of Advisors to the Superintendent, Naval Postgraduate School (NPS).
2. Objective and Scope of Activity: The Board advises the Superintendent and the Secretary of the Navy on all Naval Graduate Education programs. In accomplishing this objective, the Board also assesses the effectiveness of the School in accomplishing its mission. To this end, the Board inquires into the curricula, instruction, physical plant and equipment, administration, state of the student body, fiscal affairs and resources, and other matters relating to the operation of school programs. The Board oversees the Educational Alliance formed between the Department of the Navy and the Department of the Air Force to ensure the NPS and the Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT) meet the advanced education requirements of the Armed Forces of the United States.
3. Time Necessary for the Committee to Fulfill its Purpose: Continuing.
4. Sponsor of the Advisory Committee: Secretary of the Navy.
5. Agency Responsible for Providing the Necessary Support for the Advisory Committee: Department of the Navy (Naval Postgraduate School).
6. Description of Duties for which the Advisory Committee is Responsible: The Board advises the Secretary of the Navy on Naval Graduate Education Programs.
7. Estimated Annual Operating Costs in Dollars and Work-Years:
Operating costs: \$48,100 Work-years: 0.5
8. Estimated Number and Frequency of Committee Meetings: The Board meets semi-annually for two to three days in April and October. Occasionally, members are asked to accept specific assignments requiring their presence or their time in order to accomplish the Board's stated purpose. The Board will interact with and hold a joint meeting with the AFIT Board whenever such a meeting will improve the Alliance.
9. Membership: The Board consists of 13 authorized non-federal members to include a retired Marine Corps General Officer. The Director of Naval Education and Training; the Chief of Naval Research; the President, National Defense University; Commanding General, Marine Corps Combat Development Command (Training & Education Command); Commandant, Army War College; and Commander, Air University serve as federal members and have full voting privileges. A Chairman is selected to serve a 2-year term to prepare the meeting agenda and facilitate meetings. The Chairman will select a Vice-Chairman.
